The Dorothy Knowles Swords will be presented to the Best Novice (under two years' fencing experience at any weapon as at 1 January 2010) at Men's Foil and Women's Foil.

Competition format: 2 rounds of seeding pools with all fencers promoted to Direct Elimination round, if numbers permit.

If any entry limits are reached, reserve lists will be opened. Fencers who are placed on a reserve list will be contacted (provided sufficient contact details are given with their entry) and advised of their position on the list.

MOFT2010 is a nominated event (Tier A) in the Irish Fencing Federation ranking scheme.

MOFT is a BFA Registered Competition, held under BFA rules. As such, the following conditions of entry apply:

- Competitors must hold BFA membership at an appropriate level through one of the home country associations, or the equivalent membership of another national association.
- Membership cards must be shown at registration. Competitors without cards must take out BFA membership on the day.
- All equipment must comply with the current BFA Safety Guidelines. Random checks will be made throughout the day.
- Fencers must be aged 13 or over on 1 January 2010.

We are pleased to announce our continuing association with Leon Paul. In addition to providing scoring boxes and metallic pistes for the tournament, Leon Paul will also have an equipment stand on both days. Advance orders may be placed on 0845 388 8132 for collection at the tournament.

Directions to Greenbank Sports Academy:

- Approach Liverpool on the A59, A580 or M62.
- Turn left onto A5058 – Queens Drive (ring road).
- On Queens Drive, 1/2 mile south of the M62 junction, cross the first roundabout at Childwall Fiveways (take third exit)
- After 3/4 mile, cross second roundabout in right lane and then take middle lane for Queens Drive at following traffic lights.
- After 1/2 mile, the road passes under a railway bridge.
- After another 200 yards, turn right at traffic lights onto North Mossley Hill Road.
- After 1/4 mile, turn left onto Greenbank Lane.
- After 300 yards, Greenbank Sports Academy is on the left – the car park is signposted.
- If the car park is full, there is plenty of on-road parking outside the Academy.

Conditions of Entry

BFA Membership

The Merseyside Open is a BFA Registered Competition held under BFA rules. All fencers must hold BFA membership at an appropriate level through one of the home country associations (category names may vary according to country), or the equivalent membership of another national association, in order to compete.

Membership cards must be presented at registration otherwise BFA membership must be taken out on the day. Please note that the BFA makes a £5 administration charge for returning fees paid in cash by fencers whose membership is subsequently confirmed. We regret that we are no longer able to accept declarations of membership, in accordance with BFA instructions. Fencers who are unable to present a current membership card and who cannot pay for BFA membership on the day will not be allowed to fence.

BFA Equipment Standards

MOFT2010 will be applying the BFA equipment standards that became mandatory for all tournaments from 1 January 2006. Random checks will be made on jackets, underplastrons, breeches and masks to ensure that they comply with the standards. From 1 September 2009, foil masks must have conductive bibs that comply with BFA Rules.
